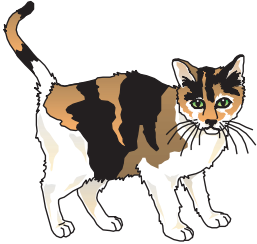
**SAVE THE LANDFILL!**

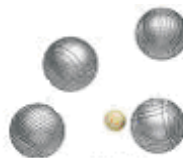
