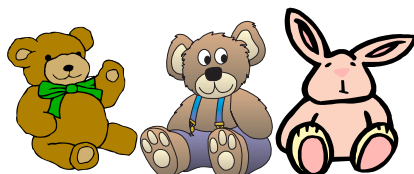

### From Your Block Captains

- This also provides a response if someone complains to a Block Captain

In a related matter, it was reported that several cars have been parked in the parking areas in front of the clubhouse and between the clubhouse and the recreation building when there seems to be no activity in the facilities. *We are aware of only 3 individuals who currently have a temporary variance to park their car in the common lot.* Please remember those lots are intended for your use while using common areas. Come explore our southern neighbor, **Socorro**, New Mexico. Stop by the Socorro Heritage and Visitors Center located at 217 Fisher Avenue and pick up the “**City of Socorro Historic Walking Tour**” brochure. Don’t feel like walking much? You can simply visit the **Mineralogical Museum** where not only a treasure trove of gold, silver and precious gems of the southwest exists, but objects of the Conquistador’s travels and travails are on display. We will meet at the museum at 2:00 PM.



No matter what you do, meet the rest of the group at the **Old Town Bistro**, located in a 100 year old adobe building in a corner of the plaza at 115 Abeyta, for a luncheon at 3:30 PM.

You will receive your choice of a cup of soup or a small house or Caesar salad and one of the following entrees from the Bistro’s lunch menu\*:

**Bistro or Veggie Burger** ~ with cheddar cheese and fries

**The Bistro Reuben** ~ on your choice of grilled pumpernickel or flour tortilla

**Philly Cheese Steak** ~ with your choice of chips, fries or potato salad

**Bistro Sandwiches** ~ Tuna Salad; Egg Salad; Ham Salad; Chicken Salad; Turkey; Ham; or Corned Beef on your choice of bread, and chips, fries, potato salad, or coleslaw.

**Salad Plate** ~ Ham, Tuna, Egg, or Chicken Salad on Lettuce and potato salad or coleslaw.

**Three Salad Plate** ~ Any three of Ham, Tuna, Egg, or Chicken Salad on Lettuce and potato salad or coleslaw.

You will also receive your choice of iced tea, soda, or coffee. (\*menu subject to change) If anyone wishes to have wine or beer or any appetizer, they will need to open their own check for these or any other extras.

After lunch, we will visit one of the oldest churches in the United States, the **San Miguel Mission** (originally built in 1627) or you can simply walk the Socorro plaza and browse through the gift shops. We will meet again at the **New Mexico Tech’s Macy Center** at



6:45 PM to enjoy the performance of the **Jazz Ambassadors of the US Army Field Band**. This official touring big band of the





United States Army, performs big band swing, bebop, Latin, contemporary jazz, standards, popular tunes, Dixieland, vocals and patriotic selections. Doors open at 7:00 PM and this free show begins at 7:30 PM.

The cost of this event is \$10 for residents and \$12.50 for guests if you want to join us for the luncheon at the Old Town Bistro. The tickets for the luncheon can be purchased by contacting Terry Baiori. (Phone number is listed in the Sunburst directory). Tickets will be sold from the February 4<sup>th</sup> Community Coffee & Donuts through the February 18<sup>th</sup> Potluck Dinner.
